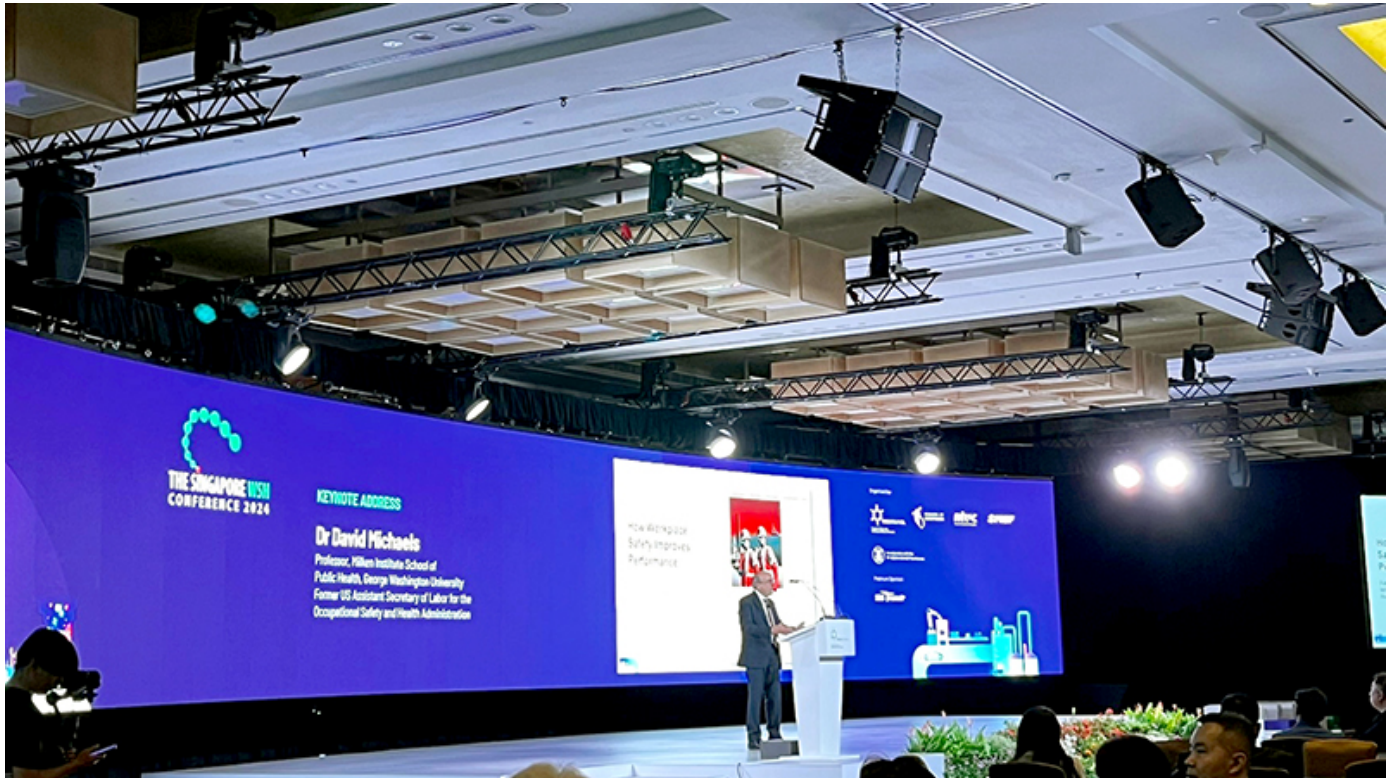




11th ASEAN-OSHNET Conference and The 5th ASEAN-OSHNET Awards Ceremony

The 5th ASEAN Occupational Safety and Health Network (OSHNET) Awards Ceremony was held on September 11, 2024, organized by Singapore's Ministry of Manpower, in conjunction with the 11th ASEAN-OSHNET Conference under the theme of WSH for Business Sustainability
