- City Development Committees

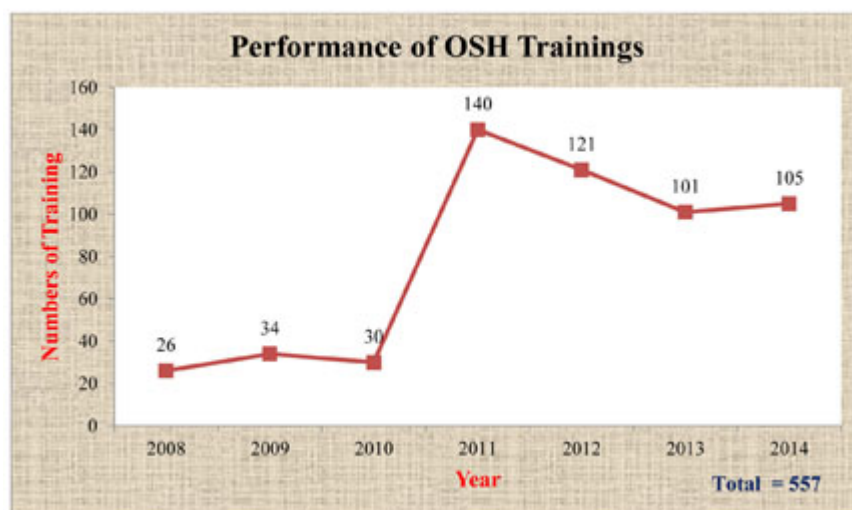
## Regional and International cooperation
